WASTE ISOLATION POWER PLANT (WIPP)

WIPP is the world's third deep geological repository licensed to permanently dispose of transuranic radioactive waste for 10,000 years that is left from the research and production of nuclear weapons. The repository is located near Carlsbad, NM. In 2014, a fire broke out at the repository, calling for evacuation. WIPP receives nuclear waste from Los Alamos and installations in Idaho, Illinois, and South Carolina.

YUCCA MOUNTAIN WASTE

The Yucca Mountain Nuclear Waste Repository was to be a deep geological repository storage facility for spent nuclear reactor fuel and other high level radioactive waste. Federal funding ended in 2010. It was to be located adjacent to the Nevada Test Site in Nye County, NV. Yucca Mountain is a cultural site to the Southern Pauite, Western Shoshone, Owens Valley Pauite, and Shoshone peoples.
